### Available Services at Askham Bar's Community Diagnostic Centre provided by Nimbuscare

The services at Askham Bar's CDC are provided by the York & Scarborough Teaching Hospitals NHS Foundation Trust, and Nimbuscare.

The available services provided by Nimbuscare are:

- → Phlebotomy (Blood testing)
- → Spirometry (Breathing test)

- 12 lead ECG
  (Assessment of heart's electrical activity)
- FeNO- Fractional
  Exhaled Nitric Oxide
  (Breath test for lung
  inflammation)
- → Ambulatory BloodPressureMonitoring
